Private lessons are \$100, semi-private lessons (two-three students) are \$50, and group lessons (four or more students) are \$25, for six 45-minute lessons. Each pool also will offer novice competitive swimming, diving, synchronized swimming and water polo teams for ages 7-17 for only \$25 for the entire summer pool season. Registration for swimming lessons and team participation is open until full.
