# R.O. Gibson Middle School Receives 1,500 Textbooks From Latin Chamber of Commerce, Another Joy Foundation & The Public Education Foundation

LAS VEGAS (April 30, 2012) – Approximately 1,500 supplemental textbooks were distributed to Robert O. Gibson Middle School students this morning as part of the mutual partnership between the Las Vegas Latin Chamber of Commerce, Another Joy Foundation, the Clark County School District and The Public Education Foundation.

The donation to R.O. Gibson Middle School is part of the larger commitment announced in February when the groups unveiled their strategic partnership called "LinkedUp for Learning." Through this collaboration to improve education, the Latin Chamber and Another Joy made an initial donation of almost 162,000 textbooks with a retail value of \$6.8 million to the Foundation for use by students and teachers in Southern Nevada.

"This is a powerful example of how public-private partnerships can impact public education," said Judi Steele, president of The Public Education Foundation. "By linking our efforts together, we are leveraging all our resources to make a measurable and meaningful difference for all our children and our future. We believe 'LinkedUp for Learning' will continue to bring much needed resources to our classrooms."

R.O. Gibson Middle School is receiving textbooks in both English and Spanish for use as supplemental teaching material in the school's Dual Language Immersion Academy. The Academy promotes academic advancement by providing students the opportunity for educational growth and positive social change as it relates to understanding and respecting different cultures and languages. The textbooks cover math, science, reading and writing.

"Another Joy Foundation is excited about positively impacting our community by joining resources to help our local education programs," said Alden Kawika Crowley, Founder of Another Joy Foundation. "Many students and families right here in the Valley will benefit from these books as well as future donations already planned. Together, we can all make a huge impact on our children here in the Las Vegas community."

"We're excited to partner with Another Joy Foundation and The Public Education Foundation on yet another delivery of school textbooks to students who need them most," said Javier Trujillo, Latin Chamber of Commerce Chairman. "Education is one of the key initiatives of our organization, and to us, the donation of these textbooks means improving our community, improving education and improving the future of both."

To date, almost 25,000 Spanish textbooks covering math, science, reading and writing have been distributed for supplemental use in dual language programs at seven CCSD schools, including Dearing, Harmon, Herron, Hollingsworth, Wengert and Walker Elementary Schools, as well as R.O. Gibson Middle School. Bracken and Hewetson Elementary Schools also received these books.

Approximately 10,000 books and instruction materials in English covering math, science, reading and writing have been delivered to 16 CCSD elementary schools. These schools include Booker, Carson, Conners, Cox, Craig, Crestwood, Culley, Detwiler, Fitzgerald, Hoggard, Lakes, McCall, Squires, Tate, Taylor and Williams.

The Foundation is working with the CCSD to screen and select the textbooks that are appropriate for use in classrooms to supplement the current curriculum. More books will be distributed in the near future. Lunas Construction and Three Square are assisting the effort by housing the books as inventory and screening takes place.

In addition, Another Joy recently donated approximately 440,000 packets of vegetable and flower seeds with a retail value of \$730,000 to the Foundation for use in classrooms.

Another Joy has additional donations of books and teaching materials on the way to the Foundation in the coming months.
