WHY: The parade is one portion of the annual Henderson Heritage Parade & Festival.

All entries are judged on incorporation of theme, creativity and overall appeal. Cash prizes are awarded to floats for 1st (\$1,000), 2nd (\$750) and 3rd (\$500) place, courtesy of several community partners. Other categories receive ribbons.

In addition, the People's Choice Award returns for a fourth consecutive year. Residents have the opportunity to vote for their favorite entry, via text message. The winner receives \$500.
