MORE THAN 7,000 CCSD STUDENTS TO ATTEND LAUNCH OF FOURTH ANNUAL READING COMPETITION

Celebrities, elected officials, educational leaders, student-athletes to promote Rebel Reading Challenge sponsored by SuperPawn and UNLV Athletics

WHAT:

SuperPawn and UNLV Athletics are teaming up with the Clark County School District (CCSD) to bring more than 7,000 fourth and fifth grade students from 37 schools to the Thomas & Mack Center for the "Rebel Reading Challenge" Kickoff Celebration.

The second annual reading competition launch event features a friendly basketball competition between UNLV President Neal Smatresk and CCSD Superintendent Dwight Jones, appearances from UNLV coaches and student-athletes as well as media personalities. The event launches the "Rebel Reading Challenge," a 30-day competition designed to motivate students to read. Winning classrooms receive free tickets and transportation to a UNLV men's basketball game and a classroom pizza party.

Created by SuperPawn as a community outreach initiative four years ago, the Rebel Reading Challenge has evolved from a 16-school competition to include students from 37 schools this year. SuperPawn is underwriting the cost of busing the students to the Thomas & Mack along with other prizes. Spread the Word Nevada, a non-profit dedicated to literacy, is providing each student with a book.
