

Skydiving PE Teacher to land at School Carnival

Las Vegas: The Sky is the limit or is it the ground, for Harmon Elementary Physical Education teacher Jim Dolan when he and three friends skydive from a plane into the school's Parent Teacher Association (PTA) Carnival on May 18th at 6pm.

The annual carnival, which helps raise funds for Harmon's PTA, takes place from 4:30-7:30pm and will feature food, games and prizes. Harmon Elementary School is located at 5351 Hillsboro Lane and the landing site will be Orinda Street, behind the school grounds.

Physical Education teacher Jim Dolan, a professional skydiver with more than 4,000 jumps, will lead other members of Extreme Aerial Media, Brian Moler, Jake Moler, and Kyle Leseberg in a demonstration skydive.

A native of Easton Pennsylvania, Dolan has been with Clark County School District since 1996, the same year he began skydiving. He has been a skydiving instructor and member of the Flying Elvi skydive team since 1998, and owns Extreme Aerial Media, a company that puts company logos on parachutes and skydives into venues all over the country. The May 18th jump will not be his first at Harmon; they go back more than 14 years.

"This skydive has become an annual tradition at our school," Dolan said. "We look forward to this opportunity for the community to join together and support education."

Admission to the carnival is free and game tickets are currently on sale at the school site.
