**Canyon Springs High School earns GRAMMY Signature Schools
Enterprise Award**

School will receive \$5,500 grant for efforts and commitment to music education

LAS VEGAS – Canyon Springs High School was recently honored by the GRAMMY Foundation with the 2015 GRAMMY Signature Schools Enterprise Award. As an economically underserved school, Canyon Springs High School is being recognized for its commitment to music education and has received a grant of \$5,500.

Canyon Springs High School is one of only 13 U.S. schools honored with this prestigious merit, out of more than 20,000 candidate schools considered by the GRAMMY Foundation. It is also the only school in Nevada that was recognized as a Signature School for 2015. The school plans on distributing the grant money it has received through this award among all performing arts groups on campus.

Created in 1998, the GRAMMY Signature Schools program provides funding for and recognizes the top public schools in the nation that help to raise awareness to the importance of serving students through excellent music programs.
