Nevada College Kick Start Program Set to Launch Second Year Program aims to improve Nevada's college graduation rate

Carson City—State Treasurer Kate Marshall will be joined by Clark County School District Superintendent Pat Skorkowsky, school administrators, students, teachers, and over 200 parents to launch the second year of the Nevada College Kick Start Program. Approximately 35,000 accounts were opened in Nevada during the initial College Kick Start launch in 2013. Roughly 35,000 additional accounts are being opened for this year's kindergarten class.

Kindergarten students will be attendance with their specially designed "I'm going to college" T-shirts, as will their teachers.

The Nevada College Kick Start Program is helping support the dream of a college education by establishing \$50 college savings accounts for all public school kindergarten students attending school in Nevada.

In all, the statewide expansion includes nearly 35,000 kindergarten students across the state. The Program is using a portion of program manager fees, <u>not taxpayer dollars</u>, to open these college savings accounts.
