CCSD Board of Trustees elects its officers for 2015

New president, vice-president and clerk were chosen to represent CCSD students

LAS VEGAS – During a recent Clark County School District (CCSD) Work Session meeting on Jan. 7, the Board of School trustees voted to elect its officers for 2015.

Trustee Dr. Linda E. Young represents District C and is School Board president. Dr. Young was first elected to the board in Nov. 2008, and then re-elected in Nov. 2012. She served as the clerk in 2009, vice-president in 2010, president in 2012 and again vice-president in 2013. Dr. Young was a CCSD employee for more than 32 years, having taken on various roles including teacher, principal and administrator.

Trustee Chris Garvey represents District B and is School Board vice-president. She was first elected in Nov. 2008, and this is her first time serving an officer position. In addition to her commitment to education, Trustee Garvey is also a dental health professional.

Trustee Deanna L. Wright represents District A and is School Board clerk. Trustee Wright was first elected to the board in Nov. 2008 and most recently served as vice-president in 2012. Prior to her election to the board, Trustee Wright was an active parent volunteer and even served as school PTA President.

"It is an honor to serve as CCSD Board of School Trustees president," said Dr. Young. "I, along with my fellow officers and members of the board, are committed to our students, staff and schools, and will continue to work together to represent the diverse needs of our parents and the community in order to increase student achievement."
