Summer education opportunities are available to CCSD students ***Summer school provides students with the chance to catch up or move ahead***

LAS VEGAS – The Clark County School District (CCSD) will begin offering summer school instruction on Monday, June 15, as the first of two summer sessions that will be available to students. Taking classes during the summer provides middle and high school students with the opportunity to make up missed credits through “credit retrieval,” or the chance to get ahead by taking advantage of the courses offered.

“Summer school plays an important role in the success of our students,” said Superintendent Pat Skorkowsky. “These summer sessions offer our seniors who are missing credits to make up classes and participate in our August graduation ceremony. The district’s summer courses also provide our accelerated students with the option to move ahead and complete their requirements early.”

One of the key factors for students who are looking to take summer courses, is that they must register through the counselor’s office at their respective school no later than Thursday, June 11. Payment must be made online at ccsd.net/schools/summerschool and the cost is \$100 per one-half credit.

There will be 11 different summer school sites at various locations around the Las Vegas valley. Students must provide their own transportation. For a complete list of summer school locations, courses, dates, times and contact information, visit ccsd.net/schools/summerschool.
