**LAS VEGAS** - The Clark County School District (CCSD) will begin offering summer school instruction on June 16. Taking classes during the summer provides middle and high school students with the opportunity to make up missed credits through "credit retrieval" or the chance to get ahead by taking advantage of the courses offered.

"Summer school is an important part of the academic calendar," said Superintendent Pat Skorkowsky. "Taking advantage of the education opportunities offered during the summer can have a great impact on student success. Summer opportunities also allow our seniors who are missing credits to make up classes and graduate in August. The district's summer initiatives provide the perfect chance for students to catch up or move ahead."

**Session Two: July 7 - July 24** Times: 7:30 a.m. – 12:15 p.m.

- All course offerings are subject to change and cancellation based on enrollment.

- Openings in classes may be limited or closed during late registration.
